The changes set forth below are to be made to the Request for Proposals dated April 30, 2025.

**Section 10.9 Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises**

**Section 10.10 Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises**

Section 10.9 and 10.10 are hereby deleted in their entirety and replaced with the revised versions set forth below.

**10.9 Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises**

It is the policy of the Olympic Authority to foster and promote participation of New York State Certified Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and New York State Certified Women-Owned Business Enterprises (WBE) (collectively, MWBE) in its procurements and the development of such enterprises and to facilitate a fair share of the awarding of procurement contracts to such enterprises.

For the purposes of this procurement, the Olympic Authority has determined that a sufficient number of qualified MWBE prime contractors are available to perform the required services. Accordingly, this procurement is designated as a discretionary purchase for participation by MWBEs in accordance with State Finance Law § 163(6)(d).

**10.10 Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises**

It is the policy of the Olympic Authority to increase participation of certified New York State Certified Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises (SDVOB) in its procurements, in furtherance of Article 17-B of the New York State Executive Law.

For purposes of this procurement, the Olympic Authority has determined that a sufficient number of qualified SDVOB prime contractors are available to perform the services required. Accordingly, this procurement is designated as a discretionary purchase for participation by SDVOBs in accordance with State Finance Law § 163(6)(d).
